

## Royal Society Library Inter-library loan policy

The Royal Society Library will lend:

• Monographs published post-1950

The Royal Society Library will not lend:

- Reference material
- Fragile items
- Periodicals

The Royal Society Library will photocopy within copyright limits, but not fragile items.

## Charges

Book loan and scanning charges will be administered via the British Library Document Supply Service. Please supply a valid BL account number.

## Other information

The book loan period is 21 days, and loans may be renewed twice.

If you fail to return or renew a book at the end of its loan period, your borrowing privileges will be suspended.

If you lose a book, or return a book in a damaged, stained or otherwise unusable condition, you will be liable to pay for a replacement copy at the current market price.
