

# Open Access Membership

Open access membership is the way your institution supports you to publish open access in Royal Society journals. Many researchers must publish open access as part of their funding requirements. Our open access policies are fully compliant with the requirements of a range of funders including the Wellcome Trust, HEFCE, NIH, Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, HHMI, RCUK, European Commission, MRC, NERC, STFC, ESRC, EPSRC and BBSRC.

Once you have decided the most appropriate home for your research you can read the guidelines for authors available for each of the journals. When you submit your paper you'll be prompted to confirm that you are submitting from a member institution and the discount will be applied to your APC payment.

When you publish with the Royal Society you'll keep 100% copyright through Creative Commons license CC-BY 4.0.
