

## Photography at Royal Society events

Permission for Schools Groups

At certain times during Royal Society events, there will be photography for both publicity and evaluation purposes. These photographs (including video and audio recordings) could be used as below:

- In printed or online promotional material promoting the work of the Royal Society
- This could include:
  - On the Society's website, our podcast or social media sites, including Facebook, Twitter and YouTube
  - o In the media newspapers, magazines, websites, broadcast outlets
  - o In joint work with partners of the Royal Society to promote our work

**Please note**: Sometimes the case study and/or film and/or photograph and/or recording may be used as an individual story in the media or promotion of our activities or programmes. However, once your photography/story/film/recording has been used, we're no longer able to control if it is used again by the same media outlet or potentially elsewhere.

Visitors may be photographed throughout the events. If any of your students (or you) would prefer **not** to be photographed, they will need to collect a sticker from the information desk so that they can be identified. This sticker must be visible at all times. Please ensure you have checked your own schools' photo permission policy, particularly with regards to children in local authority care (LAC).

In line with data protection policies, photographs may be stored for up to 3 years, after which they will be removed from our archives.
