The Summer Science Exhibition is the Royal Society's flagship public engagement event that takes place annually during July in central London.

Featuring 21 exhibits of cutting-edge science from across the UK, the exhibition provides a unique opportunity to engage a diverse audience with your work. Using hands-on activities and demonstrations, you can raise the profile of your research and institution with key influencers including potential funders, government and the public. We welcome proposals from researchers in academia, industry and in between, as long as the project lead is UK-based.



- Interactive potential and hands-on elements; and
- Interest of research to a broad audience.

Is there a fee to take part?

There is no entry charge to exhibit, however building an effective exhibit and resourcing during the week does cost. A successful exhibit can be built on a variety of budgets.
